The 7th edition of the IISFA Forum aims to offer a meeting opportunity for Law Enforcement Agencies, professionals, academic and industry-related researchers belonging to the various, vast communities of **Computer Forensics** and **Computer Security**. Two main areas are intended to be the catalyst and the aggregation stimuli for the overall event: from a technology viewpoint, Computer Forensics faces the need for advanced, intelligent, reliable and user-friendly technologies, especially in critical cases; at the same time, from the point of view of doctrine and jurisprudence Computer Forensics analyzes and explores the themes of computer investigation and proper evidence acquisition. Technological progress and evolution towards technology "cloud" on one hand require the adaptation of the rules of the Code of Criminal Procedure and on the other the need to use the tools covered by the Convention of Budapest.

IISFA Forum provides an interesting opportunity to present and discuss the latest advances and applications in such a multidisciplinary context. Submissions are therefore encouraged to refer to the Forum focus scenarios, and topics are (but not limited to) the following:

- Deep web: anonymity in the Net
- Cloud Forensics

## Paper submission

Authors are invited to submit manuscripts written in either **Italian or English**. All submissions will be refereed by at least three experts in the field through a process of double blind review and will be selected on the basis of originality, significance, quality and clarity. Accepted papers will be included in the **IISFA Member Book** to be published by the end of 2014. The Registration of **at least one author per paper** and the **author's participation in the Forum** is required for inclusion in the Proceedings. Papers should not exceed **900 words** and should comply with the format of a **PDF file**. Submitting authors should visit the Forum website **www.iisfa.net** for instructions.
